Time to Cook: Berries with Sour Cream

Ingredients:

2 cups fresh berries (any variety and mix it up if you like)
½ cup sour cream
2 tbsp brown sugar
½ tsp ground cinnamon

Prep time: 10 minutes Total time: 10 minutes

Serves: 4



Directions:

Clean and cut strawberries in halves or quarters, if using. Combine berries together in a medium bowl.

Thoroughly combine sour cream, brown sugar and cinnamon.

Spoon sour cream mixture over berries and mix, family style, or spoon berries into individual serving dishes and spoon sour cream mixture over. Add a mint leaf or two for garnish, if desired.
