Shop for a tote

Windsor Farmers Market is giving away tote bags to our faithful customers. Stop by any vendor and pick up your punch card to shop the market and shop your way to a Windsor Farmers Market tote bag. These bags are made from reclaimed cotton from clothing factories and a portion of our purchase price went to efforts to help the environment. All you have to do is make purchases totaling \$50 (\$5 increments per "punch"). It can be 10 \$5 purchases, 5 \$10 purchases, etc.



Time to Cook: Cucumber and Tomato Salad with Feta

Ingredients:

1 medium cucumber, large dice (1/2" or so)

1 pint grape tomatoes, quartered Small bunch fresh dill, minced 2 tbsp balsamic vinegar (or to taste)

½ cup crumbled feta cheese Salt and pepper to taste

Prep time: 15 minutes
Total time: 15 minutes

Serves: 4

Directions:

Prepare cucumbers and tomatoes and put into a medium mixing bowl.

Add minced dill, balsamic, feta and salt and pepper. Toss thoroughly, coating the vegetables and cheese with the balsamic and mixing everything thoroughly.

Refrigerate at least 1 hour or until ready to serve. This can be made several hours or up to one day in advance.
